**Workshop 1 hour**

To compliment your tailored workshop, a tour of the ship will be conducted by the Education Officer and themed to focus on the interesting parts of ship itself. So come and sign up for a life at sea!

Your class will learn the proper terms for various parts of the ship, explore the navigational equipment on board and enter the chartroom to see where Scott and his officers planned their voyage. There will be the opportunity to carefully handle historical objects which were vital to every sailor. Learn more about the types of jobs on board and the harsh realities of a life at sea. During the workshop your pupils will try their hand at knot-tying, will handle tools used to build and maintain the ship and will learn all about deciphering flag codes by working in teams.
