Our wine labels are all based on the caricatures drawn by crew member A J Bloggs during the Antarctic winter of 1901 and 1902 for the South Polar Times. The publication was produced for the crew of Discovery during the British Antarctic Expedition of 1901-04 and had the lowest possible circulation for any newspaper in the world. A fact that would bring tears to the eye of any media mogul. Every single person on the continent of Antarctica read it.

For good measure, the paper also had a startlingly impressive list of editors that included polar exploration leader Ernest Shackleton.
